Brexit

Sencon is a supplier of specialist sensors, controls and metrology to the metal packaging industry. For over 30 years our UK factory has been supplying products and technical support to customers in Europe, Asia, Africa and Australasia. Our products are manufactured in the UK and in the USA. We have significant experience in worldwide import and export and the challenges of commodity codes, tariffs and customs processes.

Since the UK decision to withdraw from the European Union in March 2017, a process that has become known as Brexit, we have been carefully monitoring the potential risks, disruptions and negative impacts that Brexit could have on our customers. To this end we have produced and are actioning a multi-point plan to prepare for changes created by Brexit, including the possibility of a 'no deal exit' on 1st January 2021, and mitigate as far as is possible the impacts this might have on our customers.

We are actively monitoring all guidance and support information issued by the UK government and are preparing our staff and systems for increased requirements of documentation and import/export processes. We will work with vigor with our partners in the logistics and freight forwarding operations to optimize deliveries and customs clearance.

In addition, we are identifying those products that are critical to our customers manufacturing process and increasing our stock levels to mitigate against UK import delays. We also have contingency plans for utilizing non-UK held stocks for our customers outside the UK.

We have considered the impact on the mobility of our employees and the effect on our business including financial and cash requirements. We are fully confident in the continuity and normal operation of the business during the transition period.

It would be arrogant to claim that there will be no disruption or delays at borders or through customs so we will work closely with our customers, supply chain partners and advisers and continue our preparations through the coming weeks, monitoring the situation closely. I would like to reassure our customers that Sencon will endeavor to operate as an effective supplier and business partner through the Brexit process and on to a positive productive future.
